- 10. The Treasurer presented all records for review. Motion by Member Costello, second by Member Hoffer to have Esserman & Pelter prepare the annual report. All aye; motion carried.
- 11. Salaries for 2010: Motion by Member Costello, second by Member Hoffer to increase all salaries by 4%. All aye; motion carried.
- 12. Motion by Member Costello, second by Member Vesely to appoint Oliver Blaise of Coughlin & Gerhart as our attorney for 2010. All aye; motion carried.
- 13. Discussion of inspection dinner gifts. We will give all members two points plus a small gift.
- 14. Discussion of keyless entry system.
- 15. Discussion of valve actuator replacement at station #1. Air Temp gave us three alternatives: Option #1-Replace the current valve, which is custom made, cost is \$955 but will take a minimum of 9 weeks Option #2 - Retrofit a valve which is readily available to work on our system (1 week delivery) estimate \$1300 Option #3 - Rework current system so that stock valve will fit \$1800

Motion by Member Costello, second by Member Hoffer to retrofit valve (Option #2). All aye; motion carried.

- 16. Still waiting on our FEMA grant. We were asked to update our financial information which is hopefully a sign that we may hear on our grant soon.
- 17. Discussion of midi pumper. Chief is working on specs and hopes to go out to bid in January.
- 18. Received a quote to add three additional camera at station #1. Members felt an additional camera was required in the community room. Motion by Member Costello, second by Member Vesely to approve \$2500 for the addition of four CCTV cameras at st #1, an \$800 deposit is required when they order is placed with Sentry. All aye; motion carried.
- 19. Member Costello is working on a quote for a P. A. System in the community room. He is also getting quotes on replacing ceiling tiles, updating the kitchen, and purchasing new dishes.
- 20. Member Vesely said he would like to get moving on the demo of the old alarm system in the front hallway.
- 21. Discussion of recent PESH inspection by NYS Department of Labor. We did well, the new gear and rescue ropes put us in compliance. We need to get everyone in to take SCBA and Bloodborne pathogen/Right to know training.
- 22. Discussion of possibly using the end of the hallway, beyond the maintenance room, as a storage room. Need to check codes but do not feel this hallway is necessary since there are two other exits from this hallway.
