RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE FROM APPARATUS CAPITAL RESERVE

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Endwell Fire District of the Town of Union, County of Broome, State of New York, duly convened in regular session on January 29, 2026, hereby does RESOLVE as follows:

WHEREAS, the Endwell Fire District previously established an Apparatus Capital Reserve Fund pursuant to New York General Municipal Law §6-g for the purpose of financing the acquisition and improvement of fire district apparatus and related equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District has acquired two new Chief vehicles to support emergency response, command, and operational readiness; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to outfit said vehicles with emergency lighting, communication equipment, safety equipment, and related upfitting items to place them into service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners has determined that such expenditures are an appropriate and authorized purpose of the Apparatus Capital Reserve Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Endwell Fire District hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$46,254.95 from the Apparatus Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of outfitting two Chief vehicles, including but not limited to emergency lighting, sirens, communications equipment, interior and exterior accessories, and related installation costs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be subject to permissive referendum in accordance with New York General Municipal Law §6-g and Fire District Law §175; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fire District Secretary is hereby directed to cause a Notice of Adoption of this resolution to be published and/or posted as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no funds shall be transferred or expended pursuant to this resolution until the expiration of the thirty (30) day permissive referendum period, provided that no valid petition is filed.
